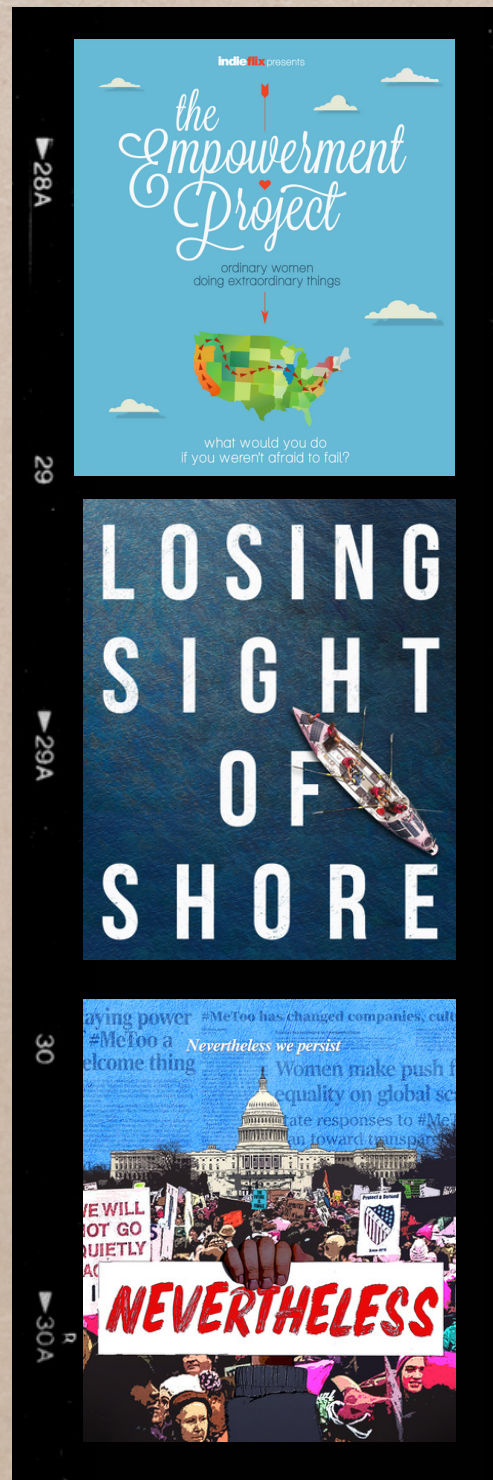
Bring Emmy Award-Winning Filmmaker Sarah Moshman to your college or university!
